
## ARTMEETSPEOPLE meets Earth

The program raises awareness and empowers creative communities to adopt sustainable practices, serving as an effective tool for transdisciplinary development








Art Meets People engages local communities to implement sustainable solutions, offering a flexible model that can be adapted and replicated globally



### ARTMEETSEARTH - Zanzibar Pilot

ARTMEETSEARTH began as a pilot in Zanzibar, a tourist hotspot where plastic waste is often burned on streets. The program collects beach waste and transforms it into artistic products with practical uses, reducing plastic pollution and promoting responsible consumption.

By actively involving the local community,
ARTMEETSEARTH nurtures creativity, supports professional
development, and builds ecological awareness. The initiative aligns
with global pro-ecological trends like #ZeroWaste,
#ProtectNature, and #Sustainability, showcasing the
potential for scalable impact.



### ARTMEETSEARTH ZANZIBAR - Cultural Collaboration

Launched in 2021, ARTMEETSEARTH Zanzibar draws inspiration from the cultural collaboration with local arts of UNESCO-listed Stone Town. The initiative highlights cultural heritage while supporting local artists through partnerships like **DESA** Unicum.Collaboration with African Foundations #PortaFoundation, #OmenaaFoundation, and #ArtMeetsPeople enriched the project, fostering knowledge exchange during a panel discussion at Desa Unicum in Warsaw.

## ARTMEETSEARTH - Global Cooperation

**In India,** trash and marine debris increasingly threaten the coast's natural beauty, marine life, and the well-being of local communities. Addressing these issues requires sustainable tourism, stricter waste regulations, and regular clean-up efforts provided by <u>Waste Warriors</u>

**In Brazil, Boiçucanga Beach** struggles with urban and river-borne litter, including cigarette butts, affecting sensitive ecosystems near protected areas. Better waste practices and public awareness are key to preserving its environment. <u>Kaysaa Residency</u> is the hub that will allow us to work with the local community and institutions as <u>Instituto Supereco</u>, Mar limpo, <u>Plastic Fisherman</u>, Lixo Zero, <u>Instituto Argonauta</u>.

**South Sinai, Egypt,** faces similar challenges, with plastic waste and fishing gear polluting pristine waters and endangering coral reefs, vital to its marine biodiversity and tourism. Poor waste management further exacerbates the problem, requiring coordinated solutions. <a href="https://example.com/HEPCA">HEPCA</a> and <a href="https://example.com/Banlastic">Banlastic</a> are some of the cooperatives that are in our plans to team up with.




#### ART MEETS PEOPLE - FOUNDATION
